What-To-Bring List

General Items:

- Bible
- Pen or pencil and notebook
- Flashlight (and extra batteries)
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- 2 Towels (1 for shower/1 for pool)
- Water bottle
- Bag for dirty clothes

Clothing:

- Shorts
- Shirts
- Long pants/jeans
- Swimsuit (girls must wear a one piece suit or bring a t-shirt to cover)
- Socks and undergarments
- Sleepwear
- Raincoat or poncho
- Something to wear to and from the showers
- Sneakers or comfortable walking shoes
- River shoes (shoes must have a back to them)

Bedding:

- Pillow and pillow case
- One fitted/one flat single sheet and an extra blanket **OR** a sleeping bag

Optional Items:

- Medication (please check-in all medications (even over the counter at registration on the opening day; Please do not pack any medication in your suitcase)
- Reading material
- Disposable camera
- Hat
- Letter writing materials (stamped envelopes or post cards)
- Your own personal life jacket (we provide life jackets, but feel free to bring your own)
- A musical instrument (if you are attending a Music, Art, and Drama Camp)
- A plain, white t-shirt to tie-dye in arts & crafts

What-NOT-To-Bring:

Please do not bring televisions, portable DVD players, video games, **wireless phones**, candy/snacks, (all refreshments are provided), fireworks, radio/CD/MP3 players, personal digital assistants, laptops, laser pointers, pagers, money (each camper receives a shirt; the bookstore is only open during Registration and Closing Program), jewelry, pets, alcohol, tobacco products, illegal drugs, knives or any other weapon.

Remember:

- ★ To label your belongings whenever possible
- ★ The camp environment is rough on clothes

Appropriate Attire:

Campers are discouraged from wearing clothing that is too revealing (such as baggy shorts, short shorts, short skirts, strapless tops, or shirts/tops that reveal a bare midriff. Female campers are asked to wear one-piece swimsuits or bring a t-shirt to cover a two-piece suit.

Mobile Phones:

Campers are asked to leave mobile phones at home during their time at camp. Please see the confirmation letter for ways to communicate with your camper. We will make sure that campers receive any emergency messages.
